Human error found to be the number one cause of breaches followed by malicious activity - OAIC Quarterly Statistics Report January 2018 - March 2018

e-Safe protects data and prevents breaches due to human error and malicious activity



NDB Scheme defines 3 types of breaches

- 1. Loss of information:** loss or theft of physical devices (such as laptops and storage devices) or paper records that contain personal information
- 2. Unauthorized access:** an employee browses sensitive records without any legitimate purpose
- 3. Unauthorized disclosure:** inadvertent disclosure of personal information due to 'human error' for example an email sent to the wrong person

e-Safe covers all 3 breaches in 3 simple steps

- Step 1. Discovers and classifies sensitive information.**
Privacy related information is discovered and classified from various sources including ERPs, CRMs and file-stores.
- Step 2. Sensitive data is protected from breach or loss using encryption.**
This ensures data remains:
 - a. protected from unauthorised disclosure.
 - b. protected in the event of a loss.
 - c. secured from unauthorised access by both internal and external users.
 - d. protected when shared with authorised 3rd parties.
- Step 3. Provides data breach monitoring and alerting.**
Monitors the access and movement of sensitive data on all corporate and non-corporate channels and alerts if it is breached.
